UKNUC Feasibility Study

“When users were asked how often they would wish to use a UKNUC for various different purposes, the idea of locating all journals in a particular subject area achieved the highest score among most groups of researchers, with support ranging from 72% to 95%, the highest score reached in response to this question. This is a definite indication of the need and support for a Serials National Union Catalogue.”

UKNUC Feasibility Study, April 2001

SUNCAT aims

- SUNCAT: freely available service
 - For **researchers & librarians**, a single tool for the location of serials, including information about access
 - For **librarians**, a central repository of high quality bibliographic records for downloading to local catalogues
- Additionally - to raise consciousness of the importance of quality serials information among UK researchers and librarians

What does SUNCAT Contain

"Serials" can be described as "... continuing resources, ... successively issued". They can include "... integrating [resources] (e.g., updating loose-leafs, updating Web sites). A serial can also include "... the following categories of finite resources (i.e., those with a predetermined conclusion): resources that exhibit characteristics of serials, such as successive issues, numbering, and frequency, but whose duration is limited (e.g., newsletters of events); reprints of serials; and finite integrating resources."

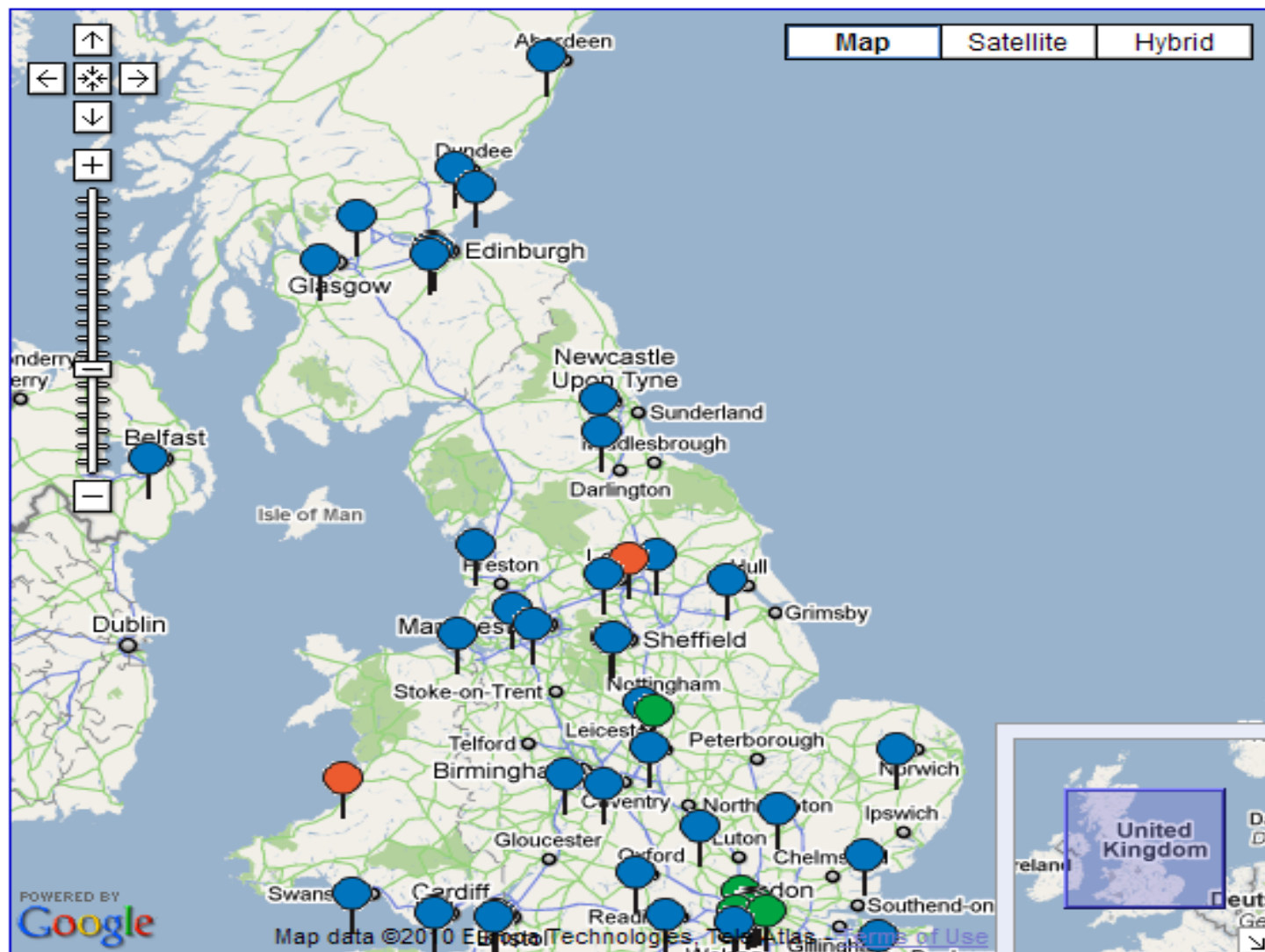
What does SUNCAT contain?

- Whatever contributing libraries define as a serial in their local catalogues
- No article level information - but links through to tables of contents and full text of articles
- Antiquarian and current titles
- Print and electronic serials

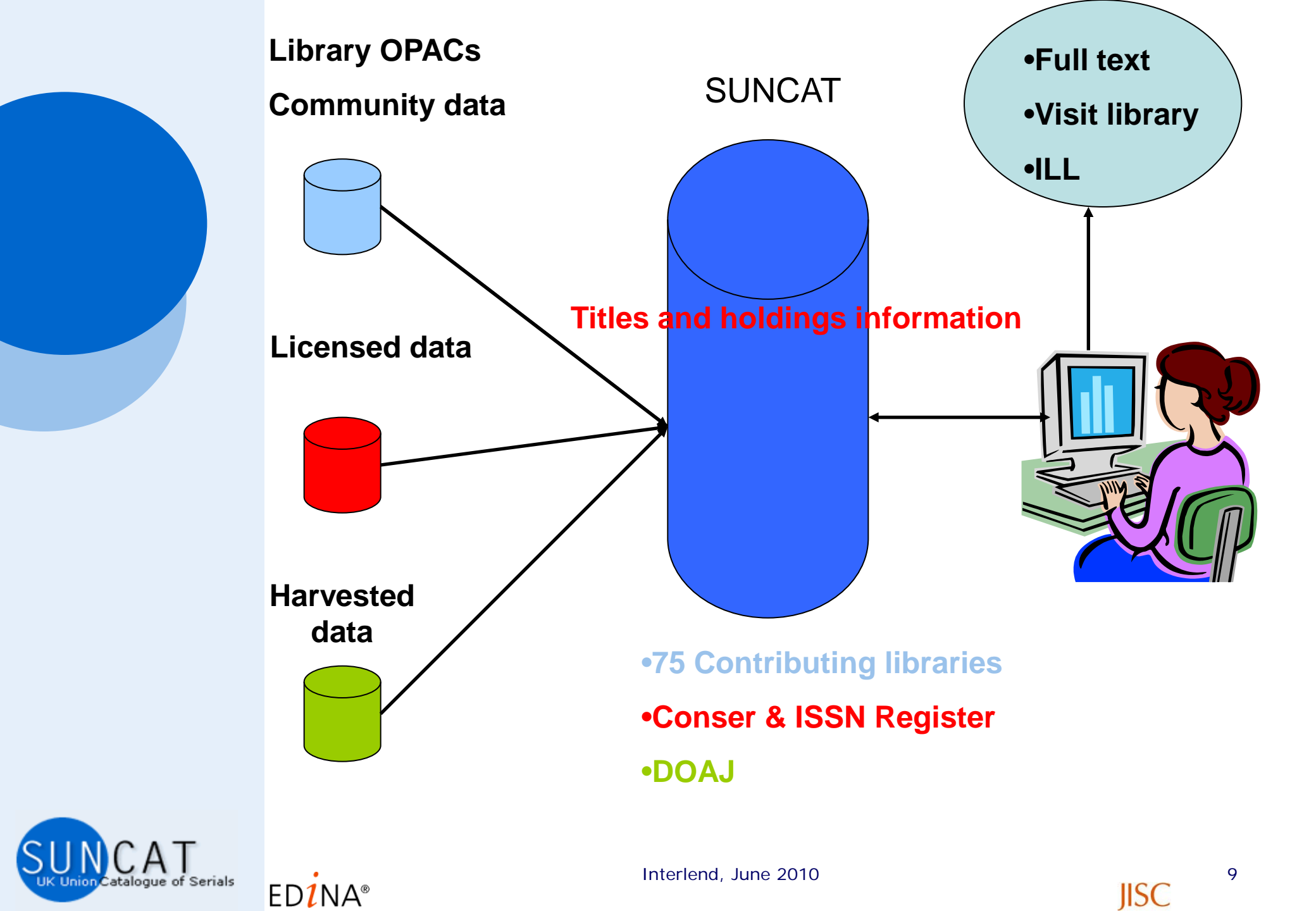

Focus on Inter-Library Loans I

- SUNCAT is freely available at the point of use
- SUNCAT contains serials holdings information from 75 UK research libraries including the British Library and is continuing to expand
- SUNCAT contains over 5 million records

Focus on Inter-Library Loans II

You can use SUNCAT to...

- Verify if you have the correct details for an ILL request
- Check if a particular serial is held in the UK
- Find where a particular serial is held in the UK
- Verify that a serial is NOT held locally
- Tailor searches to specific geographic areas or libraries, e.g. North of England
- Save/email records for future reference
- Streamline workflow
- Reduce the number of requests which need to be sent abroad or are unfulfilled

Consultation with Users

- Small survey with ILL librarians (May 2008)
- Impact and satisfaction survey with all users (April 2009)
- Downloading service interviews and survey with cataloguers (February 2010)

Priorities for Cataloguers

- Add more Contributing Libraries' records to the Z39.50 MARC downloading service
- Deduplicate records as much as possible
- Indicate record provenance on the brief record display (i.e. visible from search results screen)
- Highlight search functionality to cataloguing staff, e.g. limiting to records from specific libraries

ILL Priorities

- Addition of holding libraries to journal titles listed in the search results screen
- Adding more libraries to the catalogue, particularly public libraries
- Linking from SUNCAT holdings to the equivalent record on Contributing Libraries' local catalogues
- Linking from SUNCAT to Table of Content (TOC) services

All Users

- Impact and Satisfaction Online survey 2009
- Majority of respondents library or information professionals
- Wide range of library staff use SUNCAT
- Verified main usage of SUNCAT as tool for locating specific journals in the UK
- Also used to
 - Check bibliographic details of journals
 - Upgrade serials' records on local catalogues
 - Compare journal holdings with other libraries

Priorities for All Users

- Adding more libraries to the catalogue
- Linking from SUNCAT holdings to the equivalent record on Contributing Libraries' local catalogues
- Linking from SUNCAT to Table of Content (TOC) services
- Corroborates findings from ILL survey
- Also reducing amount of duplication on the catalogue
- Similar findings to recent OCLC report: Calhoun, K. and Cellentani, D. (2009), "Online catalogs: what users and librarians want",

- Web 2.0 & personalisation less popular, except for
 - Location focussed results (based on users' preferences)
 - Saving searches or records across sessions

ABSTRACT

The majority of the literature on the increasing labour market disparities in Japan has attributed the trend to changing market circumstances or new government policies. However, this article claims that widening income disparities, especially between regular and non-regular workers, are more deeply rooted in the nature of Japan's policy-making mechanism. Combining industrial actors' *conservative* orientation towards dual labour markets and their *corporatist* interactions for policy making, this article argues that Japan's disparity problem has originated from its '*conservative corporatism*'. The article presents the manner in which conservative corporatism has widened the disparities in employment security and welfare benefits.

Japan was once touted as the most successful example of 'shared growth' (World Bank 1993): boasting a higher growth rate and lower levels of social inequality than any other industrialized country during the 1970-1980s. 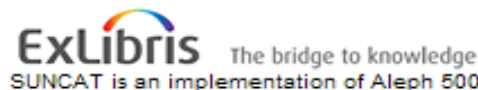

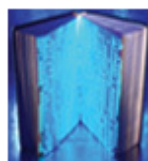

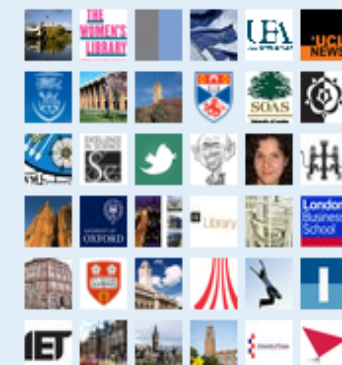
