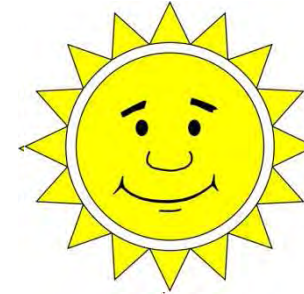

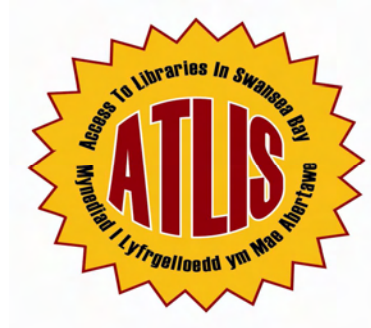
## ATLIS - Open to All



- All persons wishing to take part in the scheme will be required to become a member of either NPT or Swansea libraries
- All persons wishing to take part in the scheme will be required to produce a completed 'Open To All' passport, available from any public library



# ATLIS – Open to ALL



- Document delivery options, including collect and/or return at any ATLIS library, postal delivery etc.
- Investigating cross-catalogue searching and linking in to the CyMAL all-Wales resource discovery initiative



# SWAP Partnership



- ATLAS Open to All scheme expanded to SWAP partnership
- Feb 2009 – Cat Cymru launched
- April 2009 – Free ILLs within SWAP region
- Postage of ILLs trialled
- Over 400 customers have joined SWAP since Apr 2009



# SWAP Partnership



- 91,670 reservations
- 1627 ILLs
- 209 SWAP reservations
- 1418 Unity reservations incl 123 BL's
- 39 Cat Cymru emails from our customers
- 6 Cat Cymru emails from other institutions



# SWAP Partnership



- Strengths of the scheme
  1. Cost – no charge for customers and no charge for library service. Also, funding for postage.
  2. Customers have access to Cat Cymru
