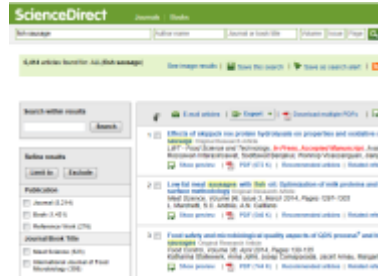

Document Supply	Provides access to in-copyright content either purchased or licenced via surrogate or loan.
Imaging (Digitisation) Services	High quality, secure and competitively priced digitisation services
Course packs	Provision of course pack (or MOOC) content through partnerships
Collaborative Storage	Based on the UKRR model, support organisational libraries save space but still guarantee access.
Ethos	Provision of PhD theses online through partnership with HE
Reading Rooms & study space	Provision of study space in London and Boston Spa

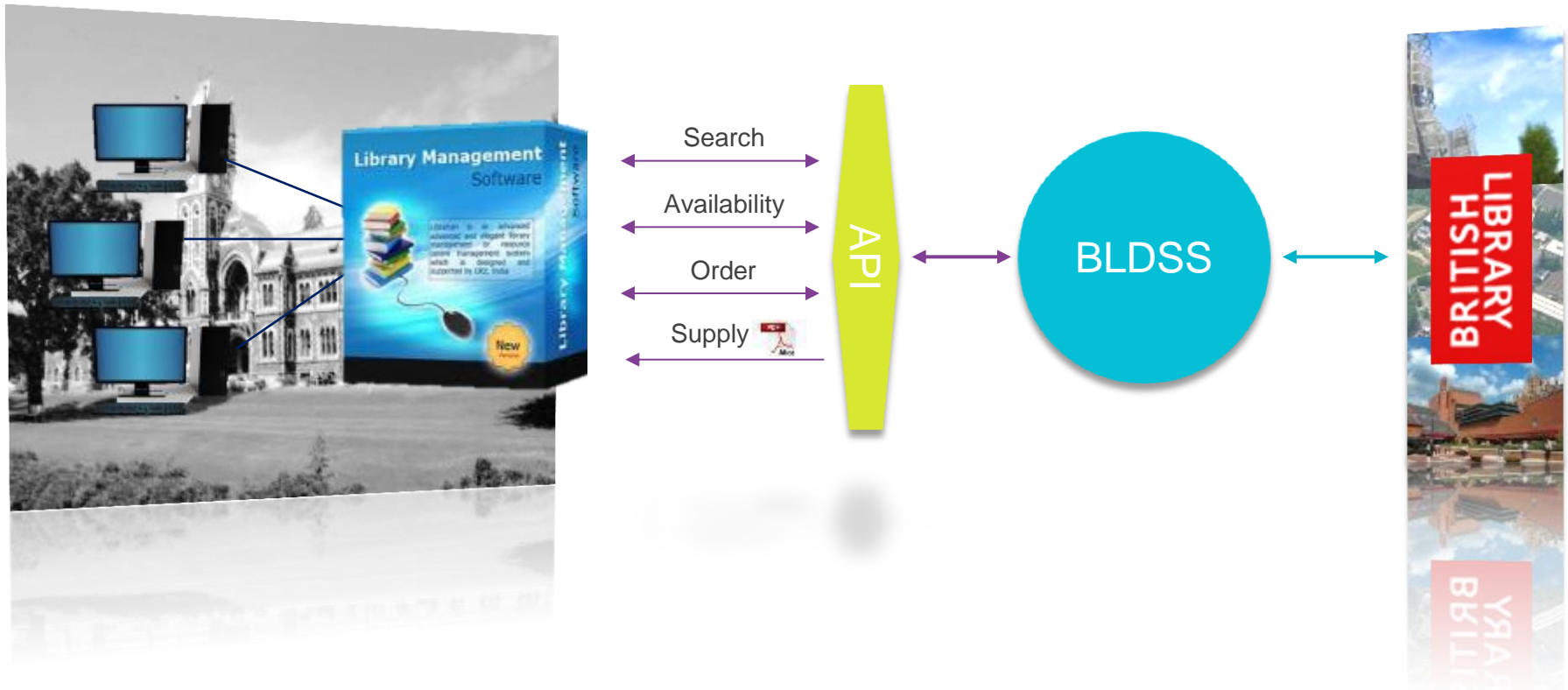

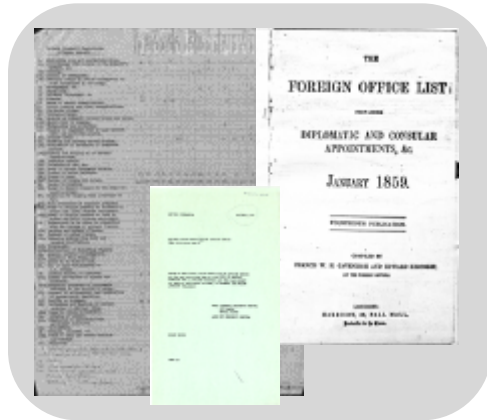

Course Packs and Reading Lists

- The student population has grown by around half a million in 10 years
- Course Packs and Reading Lists are on the increase

- Single Licence from the CLA

High Quality Scanning Trial

- 4 universities part of the trial
- Running for 4 weeks –started at the beginning of November
- High quality scans plus OCR
- Outputs of the trial will be
 - Feedback on quality of scans
 - Feedback on quality of OCR
 - BL understanding of costs of high quality
 - Engagement with the sector on next steps including proposed pricing for high quality scans with OCR

UK Research Reserve UKRR – collaborative research, storage and access

What is UKRR?

- Strategic partnership between HE sector and the British Library
- 29 member libraries, led by Imperial College London
 - Helps UK HE libraries release space
 - Preserves research material for the UKHE research community

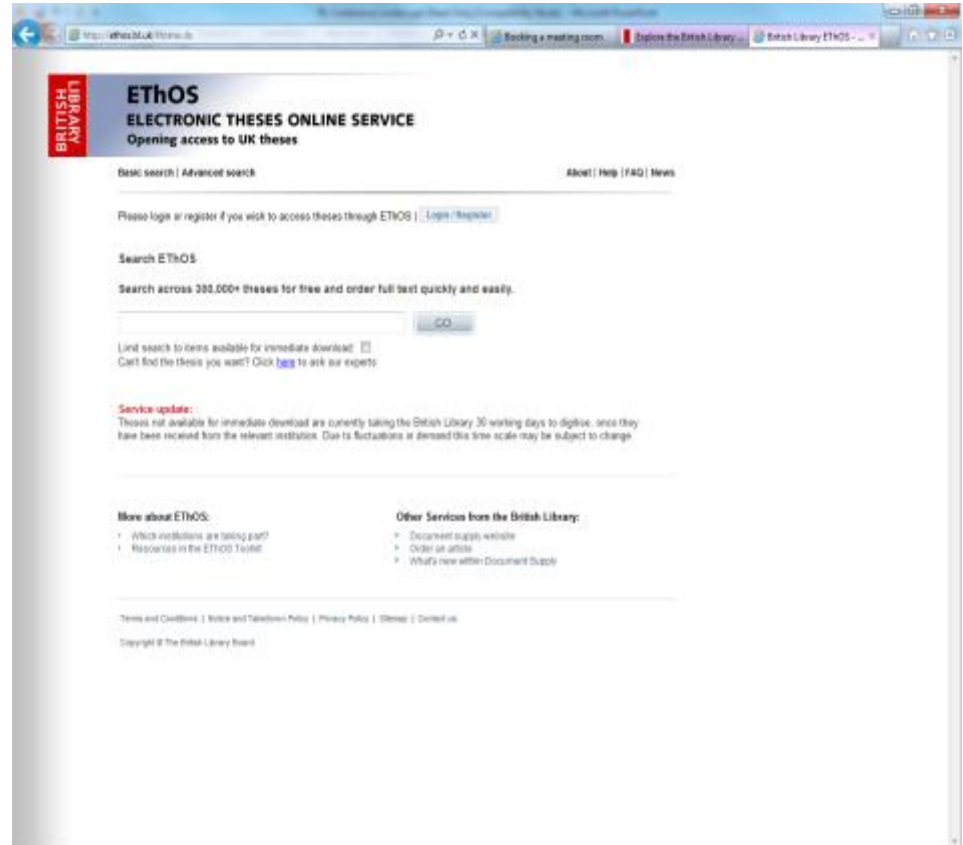

EThOS Aims

- A national *record* of all doctoral theses awarded by UK Higher Education
- Provide a UK PhD single point of access platform
- Showcase UK research globally
- Transition from print to e
- Expand the available content through digitisation
- Access to the *full text* wherever possible

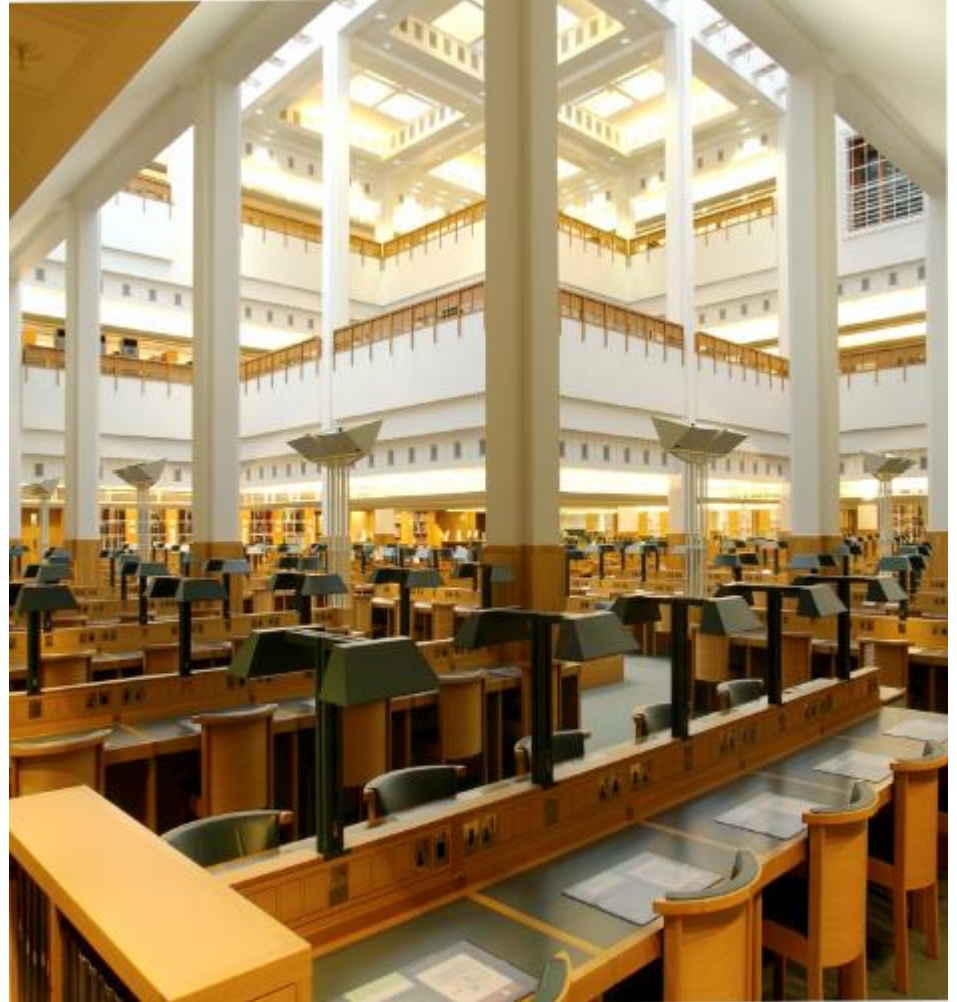


Highlights – EThOS E-Theses Online

- “The home of UK PhD theses”
- 370,000 *records* for UK theses
- 130,000 *full text theses* available for download
- 35,000 theses viewed every month by researchers
- 500 paper theses digitised every month, on demand
- All metadata available for re-use by discovery services
